

# MWR MORALE BOAT QUALIFICATION ADDENDUM & BOARD CHECKLIST FOR THE 2010 BOATING SEASON

The person applying must be an eligible MWR patron, **minimum of 18 years old and must be able to answer "YES" to at least one of the following:**

- Coast Guard Afloat CO/XO/OINC/XPO
- Coast Guard Coxswain/crewman/engineer/underway QMOW qualified
- Previous Boating Card through MWR
- Hold a Boating Safety Course Certificate

If you cannot answer "yes" to any of the above questions, you can list other experience you feel qualifies you to obtain a check-ride on the 23' morale boats. Contact the boat house for more information.

## **Procedures to attain a boating safety course certificate.**

Click on the below link and use any of the online courses to study and take the boating safety exam. After passing exam, bring certificate with the purchase price to the MWR boathouse.

**Once you can answer yes to the above criteria, patron must sit through MWR's Boathouse class and take MWR's Boathouse test. (Call boathouse for times) Before patron is given rental authority of any MWR boats, patron will need to demonstrate the following practicals.**

The candidate must:

- \_ Outline the operating area
- \_ Demonstrate mooring/unmooring
- \_ Demonstrate anchoring/weighing anchor
- \_ Demonstrate man overboard recovery
- \_ Demonstrate boat handling (transition from slow speed up to full plane and back)
- \_ Demonstrate radio operation
- \_ Demonstrate GPS/FF operation
- \_ Explain engine alarms
