May 14th will be the official season opener for the boat house.

This season, we have some exciting changes happening! Now, we'll be offering them at \$15 an hour, \$45 minimum, \$100 maximum. Rent our 23' five times and get your sixth rental free all season long.

The requirements have changed for acquiring a boat card. For those of you who already have a card for the 23', All current card holders, as well as new boaters will need to take the Boat House written test, In order to receive this years card. All new boaters will need to take a USCG Auxiliary approved Safe Boating Course or equivalent. You will also be required to take the MWR boating class and pass the test. After taking the Auxiliary approved course, come to the boathouse with your completion certificate and a receipt of payment and we'll take the cost of your course off your first boat rental.

The Auxiliary Class will be offered the first week of May in the evening. More information will follow, with dates and times.

Of course, some things have stayed the same. We still have the trusty old A frame truck campers, along with three 17' Boston Whaler utility boats for crabbing, two ATV trailers, portable outboard engines and Honda generators.

Also we are looking to gain some fishing resources for those people who do not have a Boating card. If you are willing to cost split and take people out with you on a day trip, please leave your contact information in the resource book at the boat house.
